

*Printing: After sending a print job, the Finder says the printer cannot be found. What do I do?*

AppleTalk is probably disabled.

Go to Apple Menu:Control Panels:AppleTalk, and make sure "Connect via:" is set to "Ethernet". Sometimes, it will complain that your network number is no longer valid. In any case, just close the window and save it when it asks. If it gives you a message that you do not have enough privileges, skip this step. If Multiple-Users is enabled on your machine, you will not have access to the AppleTalk Control Panel. In that case, skip to the next step.

If that doesn't work, restart your machine.

If that doesn't work, check to see if "data" or "receive" lights are blinking. Someone may be sending a big job to the printer.

If it's not blinking, ask around to make sure nobody is using the printer, then power off the printer, count to 20, and turn it back on.

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
